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Introduction

The Expression Of Interest (EOI) is the first phase of the ISAN Registration Agency (RA) accreditation and appointment process.

The aim of the expression of interest (EOI) is to provide the ISAN International Agency (ISAN-IA) with a set of non-binding information related to the organization's interest in becoming an ISAN Registration Agency in its chosen market, and to check its compliance with the ISO 15706 standard.

After approval of the EOI by ISAN-IA, the prospective RA (the organization candidate) will be asked to provide a detailed business case (i.e. implementation plans, business plan, market coverage, details on its IT infrastructure, type of customers, services offered, pricing, etc...).

All the information provided in this document is to be considered <u>as public</u> (unless otherwise specified), and therefore the organization sending this EOI allows the ISAN International Agency to publish its contents on its website, <u>www.isan.org</u>.

Main Activities	Please give a brief extensive description of your organization main activities. ANICA, member of Confindustria, represents the industrial side of the film and audiovisual sectors. Members include film producers, film and multimedia distributors, technical enterprises, firms specialized in the production of short films, advertisements and documentaries and companies that operate multiplex theatres. ANICA, founded in 1945, represents the industry in political and union affairs, in addition to promoting the Italian films at home and abroad. In Italy, it serves as the representative of the Motion Picture Academy, organising the selection of the Italian candidate for the Best Foreign Film Oscar. It is a founding partner of the David di Donatello Award. It is a member of the FIAPF, the world federation of film producers' associations and it represents the MEDIA Programme of the European Union in Italy, through the MEDIA Desk Italy. API (Autori & Produttori Indipendenti) is the most important association of Italian Independent Authors and Producers of cinema. As the first unitary structure that has overcome the gap between creators and producers of images, it has thus made everybody involved responsible for the defence of the public's right to have access to a really differentiated cultural offer the quality of which is ever increasing. Besides, being API an aggregation of forces with different cultural and entrepreneurial backgrounds that look to a modern and industrial development of the audiovisual sector, it acts a unitary interlocutor for anybody – both institutions and civil society – who wishes to modernize Italian cinema reorganizing and easing public intervention, favouring private venture capital and granting everybody the same opportunities of access to a market in which competition is ensured by certain ad transparent rules. API is working in favour of a redefinition of the mechanisms governing
	the public's right to have access to a really differentiated cultural offer the quality of which is ever increasing. Besides, being API an aggregation of forces with different cultural and entrepreneurial backgrounds that look to a modern and industrial development of the audiovisual sector, it acts a unitary interlocutor for anybody – both institutions and civil society – who wishes to modernize Italian cinema reorganizing and easing public intervention, favouring private venture capital and granting everybody the same opportunities of access to a market in which competition is ensured by certain ad transparent rules.

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	APT was established in 1994 with the purpose of representing its members towards public Authorities and television networks (both public and private), to protect their interests, to back their organizational, technological and economic development, and above all to support the needs and expectations of this sector on the occasion of national laws or EU Directives concerning television production. 54 independent production companies are members of APT: their work accounts for over 70% of the overall turnover of this sector, which amounts to some 500 million Euro per year, with an employment (either direct or included) of approximately 350.000 people. The vast participation of Italian independent producers in APT qualifies this Association as "first representative" of this category, attributing the same full title to act in the name and on behalf of its members with respect to negotiation and stipulation of economic, associative and union agreements, organizing and ensuring the proper functioning of all common services of fiscal, legal and technical assistance and advice, for public relations end for relations with the press. APT is also members of Confindustria, of "Sistema Cultura Italia" and of CEPI (European Coordination of Independent Producers) in Bruxelles, in which holds the office of Vice-President.
	SIAE – Italian collective Society which, according to Italian Copyright Law, manage authors' rights for every type of works, including audiovisual ones. For audiovisual works in particular SIAE administer and collect authors' remuneration on broadcasting rights, retransmission rights, blank tape levy, video carriers distribution rights, etc
